## **Revelation 11 – The Messengers**

- The final 5 of 7 events that mark the Interlude will take place in ch. 11
- The completion of the mystery is finished, and we see the coming of God's messengers. *He never leaves himself without a witness!*
- The lie must be consummated, blasphemy must be crowned, and then God will act in wrath.
- This chapter anticipates Rev. 13 and has its roots in Rev. 7 and 9
- We see God's two men vs. Satan's two men
- These messengers have a mandate of supernatural power, entrusted to them for a specific period of time and centered in a special place. When their voice is finally silenced, the last woe comes and the earth is soon thereafter taken from Satan's control
